Southern Nazarene University publishes a Campus Safety and Crime Report on an annual basis, in compliance with the Clery Act. The report includes statistics for the previous three years concerning reported serious crimes that occurred on-campus; in certain off-campus buildings or property owned or controlled by SNU; and on public property within, or immediately adjacent to and accessible from, the campus. The report also includes institutional policies concerning campus security.
