## WITH PREPARATION FOR GREAT JOBS AFTER GRADUATION

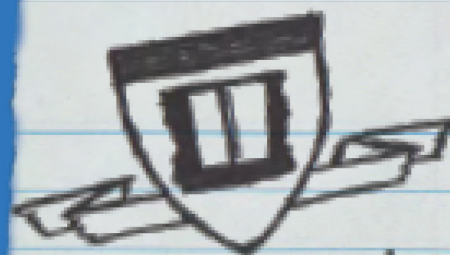

Kyra Kuik, a content coordinator for Distilled, a marketing agency in Seattle, WA.

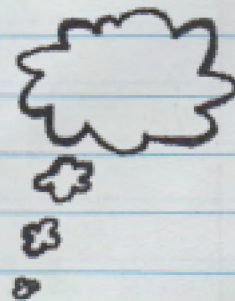
