Check-In

SHINE check-in begins at 7:00 p.m. on Thursday night, January 25 in the Hills Residential Complex on the corner of NW 39th Expressway and N. Peniel Ave. Thursday evening is designated for introducing your campus host as well as getting to know the other girls who are attending SHINE.
