

IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

The following is required by the State of Oklahoma and SNU for ALL undergraduate students attending class on campus whether full or part-time:

MMR -- 2 doses

Hepatitis B – 3 doses

Meningitis/Meningococcal – If you are living in the dorm

TSPOT – test for tuberculosis if you are an International student

YOU WILL NEED YOUR IMMUNIZATION RECORDS!

Options to get your records or get your immunizations if you have not had them.

OPTION 1 – If you are from Oklahoma or lived in Oklahoma when you were younger, the Student Health Center can check the OSIIS (OK State Health Department) website to search for your records.

OPTION 2 – Check with your high school. If you went to school in Oklahoma (other states require these also) you should have had the MMR and Hep B Series. **Call the school and have them fax your records directly to us at the numbers included below. We have a form that we can fax from our office (which requires your signature) that may get better results than if you call.**

OPTION 3 – Check with your parents/guardians. You should have a paper copy of your vaccinations that you had as a child.

OPTION 4 – Check with the doctor/pediatrician's office you went to as a child.

OPTION 5 – If you have health insurance go to a clinic and get blood test (titers) to see if you have had the vaccines in the past OR go to pharmacy and get your vaccines and submit the proof to the Student Health Center.

IF YOU ARE 18 or younger you can go to health dept. for FREE vaccines. (They want you to bring a shot record)

OPTION 6 – Compare prices from your health insurance to our clinic price (we provide at cost). You may decide to come to the Student Health Center to get your vaccines. Note: IF YOU WILL HAVE A CREDIT BALANCE ON YOUR SCHOOL BILL, IT MAY BE POSSIBLE THAT YOU COULD USE IT TO PAY FOR YOUR VACCINES.
