FAFSA: Why should I complete it?

A student is *not* required to file a FAFSA in order to be awarded an academic or Nazarene scholarship by Southern Nazarene University, *but* the financial aid department *does highly encourage* all students to file a FAFSA each school year. Why? Because there are certain financial aid awards open, only to those who have filed a FAFSA, *if applicable*.

Some of those awards include:

- Southern Nazarene University Housing grant
- Southern Nazarene University Institutional grant
- Federal Pell Grant
- SEOG Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant
- OTAG & OTEG Oklahoma state grants
- Federal Student Loans

Again, students who *do not file* a FAFSA *will not be eligible, if applicable*, for any of the above financial aid awards. The FAFSA is a *free* and *easy* tool The Department of Education uses, in determining if a student will receive any financial assistance for their schooling.
